#### Ultrasound Emphasis

EVMS is proud to be one of a handful of medical schools in the United States to have a robust ultrasound curriculum, giving our students an edge in the use of this powerful tool. You will start using ultrasound equipment the first week of school in your anatomy labs. During your clinical clerkship rotations, (in your third year), you will use hand-held ultrasound scanners frequently.

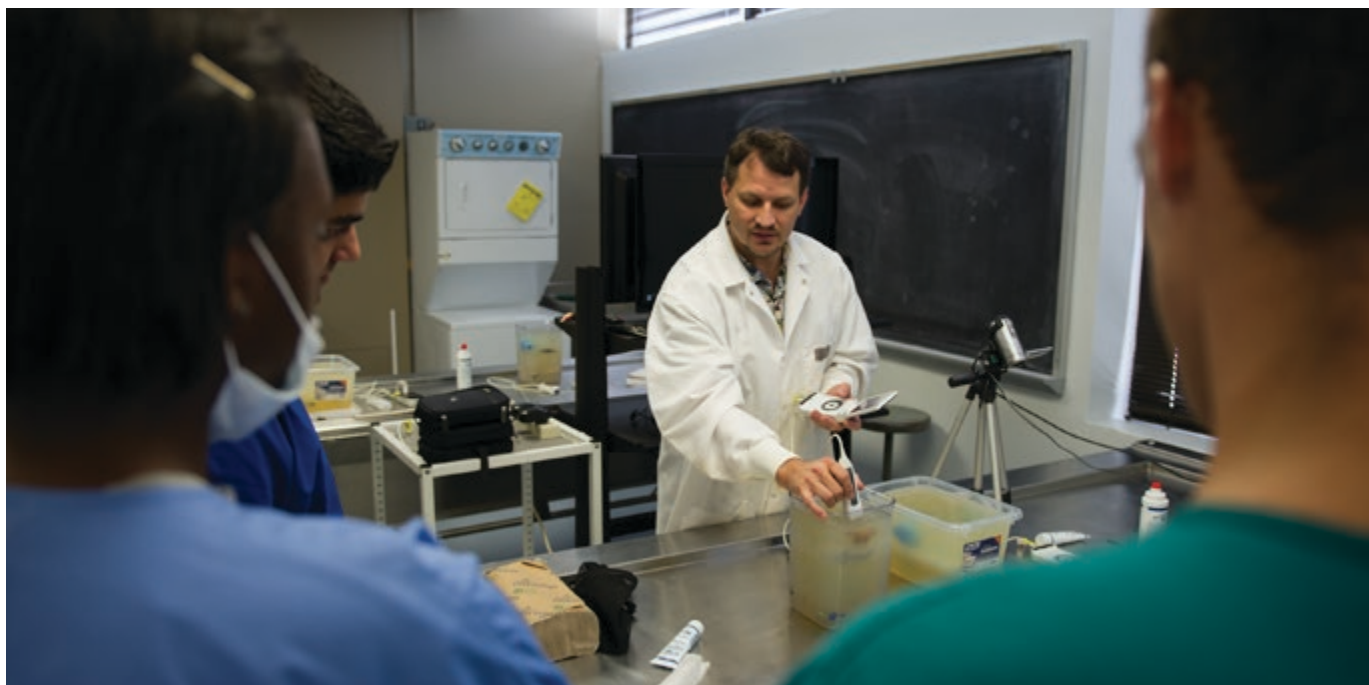

### Superior Performance on Licensing Exams

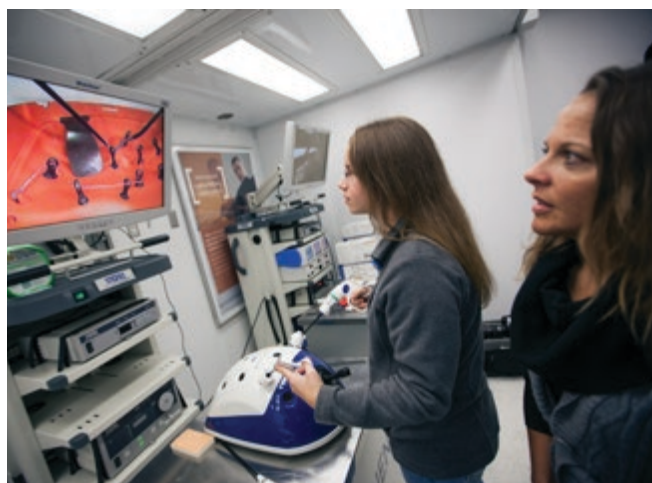
