## **Fellowships**

## Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Fellowship Update; Don Byars, MD, Fellowship Director:

The EMS Fellowship team has been hard at work over the past 3 months. In addition to our normal lecture schedule, Dr. Fox presented "Grief Life Support and Breaking Bad News" at the Tidewater EMS (TEMS) Quarterly Education Expo in January. Dr. Ford presented "Diving Emergencies" to Portsmouth EMS in March. Drs.' Lang, Byars, and Ford (and former EVMS EM resident and EPT member Martin Payne, MD) and Dr. Cutchins held an advanced airway day at the Sim Center at EVMS for all the SWAT medics in the area, that was attended by members from Norfolk, Portsmouth, Chesapeake, Virginia Beach, FBI, and SOCOM.

The EMS fellowship team is also working hard to develop whole blood transfusion protocols in the field for trauma. This will hopefully be rolling out this year, initially with Virginia Beach EMS and Sentara Nightengale. After initial rollout, we hope to make this system wide in all of the Southside EMS agencies. We are also involved with developing ultrasound in the field with EMS agencies in the TEMS region.

In regards to research, the EMS Fellowship had 2 poster presentations at the National Association of EMS Physicians (NAEMSP) conference in San Diego this past January. Drs'. Ford, Byars, Lang, and Martin attended the conference. We have also had 2 posters accepted for presentation at SAEM in New Orleans, "Adaptation of EMS Hypoglycemia Treatment in Response to COVID 19 Pandemic Supply Chain Disruption" and "Nitrous Oxide Revisited for Prehospital Pain Relief in the Opioid Crisis: A Retrospective Pilot".
