Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Fellowship Update; Don Byars, MD, Fellowship Director:

The EMS fellowship is getting ready to graduate its 3rd EMS Fellow, **Lucie "Tex" Ford MD**, and look forward to our incoming Fellow, **Dylan Woolum**, **MD**. Fortunately, Tex will be staying with EPT, completing our Emergency Ultrasound (EUS) Fellowship, so we will have the benefit of her expertise and knowledge. **Don Byars MD** and **Joe Lang MD** will be switching roles, with Joe Lang becoming Fellowship Director, and Don Byars becoming Associate Program Director, as he is starting his new job as residency Program Director. Don does like a challenge!

Recently, the EMS fellowship participated in training days with the Virginia State Police Tactical Team and VCU EMS fellowship, as well as completing a training day in June with the EUS fellowship for a resident training day. Dr. Ford recently completed the course on Medical Management of Chemical and Biologic Agents by USAMRIID at Fort Detrick, Maryland. Dr. Ford also presented at the Tidewater EMS Expo the following lectures: "Cardiac Devices from A to V," "Uncommon Causes of Sepsis," and "STEMI, Not the Only Type of Heart Attack." The EMS fellowship team is also actively working with Tidewater EMS in getting whole blood transfusion in the field started this summer, with a tentative go live date with Virginia Beach EMS on August 1, 2022. Whole Blood transfusion in the field can be a potential high value intervention, and we are looking forward to the start of this program.
