



**Advanced Trauma Life Support® Student Courses:
March 13 – 14, May 22 – 23, November 6 – 7, 2008
One-half Day Refresher Course: September 19, 2008
at the Eastern Virginia Medical School, Norfolk, VA**

The American College of Surgeons two-day student course for physicians and physician extenders combines lecture, laboratory and skill stations to teach established standards of trauma care and practical, life-saving skills. These courses are based on the 7th edition ATLS materials. Upon completion, the physician will be able to:

- Demonstrate concepts and principles of primary and secondary patient assessment.
- Establish management priorities in a trauma situation.
- Initiate primary and secondary management necessary in the early hours of emergency care.
- Demonstrate skills used in the initial assessment and management of patients with multiple injuries.

The one-half day student refresher course includes a brief lecture on course updates, plus initial assessment skills and written testing. Refresher students must have a current ATLS card or have expired status within 6 months of the refresher course.

CME Credit
