Advanced Trauma Life Support® Instructor Course
January 24 – 25, 2008
at the Eastern Virginia Medical School, Norfolk, VA

The American College of Surgeons' 1½-day ATLS Instructor course teaches doctors how to teach the ATLS program. The program includes roles and responsibilities of the instructor, course design and learning principles, miniature practice sessions, group discussion techniques and skills-teaching techniques. Enrollment is limited.

To be eligible for the instructor course, the candidate must have completed and have received an "instructor-potential" rating during an ATLS Student (or refresher) course within the past 2 years. Out-of-state applicants must also have written approval from their state or provincial Committee on Trauma chairperson to take an instructor course in another state. Provide copy of IP letter with registration (and out-of-state COT chair letter if applicable by the course date).

CME Credit

The American College of Surgeons is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) to provide continuing medical education for physicians. The American College of Surgeons designates this educational activity for a maximum of 15 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits*™. Physicians should only claim credit commensurate with the extent of their participation to the activity. Approved by the American College of Emergency Physicians for up to 15 Category 1 credits (1 hour = 1 credit).
