



SEEKING TEENS AGES 12-18 FOR RESEARCH STUDY ON SOCIAL STRESS AND SUICIDE RISK

This study will help us learn how social stress impacts suicide risk.

Who is eligible? Teens ages 12-18 who were recently in the hospital (emergency department, inpatient unit or partial hospitalization program) for suicidal thoughts or behaviors. Teens are eligible for three months after they leave the hospital.

What does the study include?

Teens and one parent will complete three phases of the study that, in total, last for 1 month:

- Phase 1: Teens and one parent will complete a one-time initial visit.
- Phase 2: Teens and one parent will complete short daily surveys on their phones for 1 month. During this time, teens will also wear a Fitbit-like watch to keep track of sleep.
- Phase 3: Teens and one parent will complete a final, brief follow-up phone interview and survey at the end of the study.

What do I get for being in the study? Teens will be paid for each part of the study – up to \$208 in cash and gift cards for participating. Parents also will be paid for each part of the study – up to \$150 in cash and gift cards for participating.
