Day 2: AI Policies

Creating effective policies for the use of artificial intelligence (AI) in higher education is crucial to ensuring responsible and beneficial AI integration. Engaging relevant stakeholders in policy development and clearly defining the objectives and goals of AI integration are the first steps in creating policy.



Ethical guidelines for AI use in education should also be created including bias mitigation, fairness, transparency, and data privacy. It is important to establish mechanisms for accountability if issues or biases arise and to prioritize data privacy through strict data protection policies.

Accessibility and inclusivity are also important considerations. AI-powered education tools and materials should be accessible to all students and should not have access barriers. Consistent feedback and evaluation of systems and policies can assist with this.



Institutions can provide training and education opportunities to understand AI technology and its integration using pilot programs before full-scale implementation. Interdisciplinary collaboration and responsible procurement of tools should be utilized.
