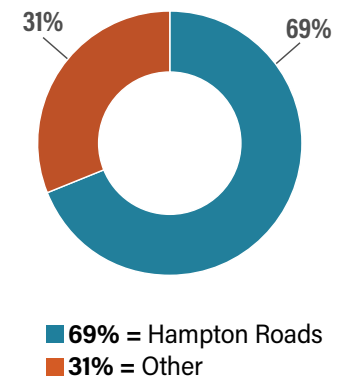

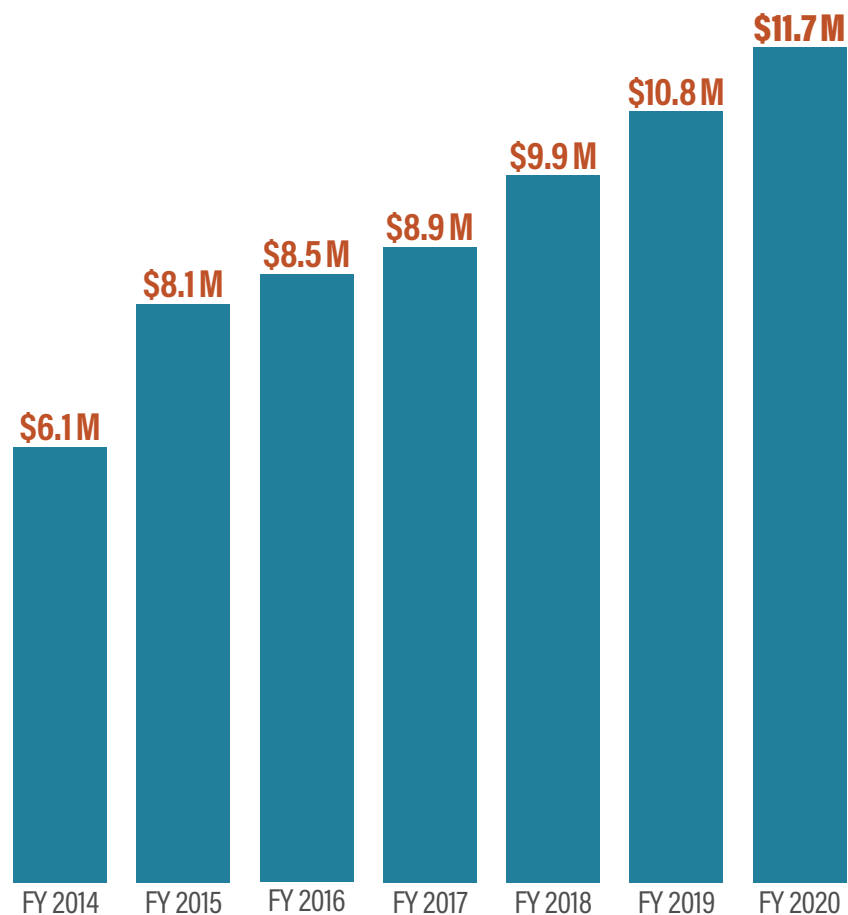

Financial Information

In addition to strengthening the EVMS educational mission by managing more than 20 educational programs and establishing new programs, the SHP makes a significant contribution to the institutional core budget. As depicted in the bar chart, the SHP net excess increased substantially between FY2014 and FY2020 from approximately \$6.1 million to \$11.7 million.

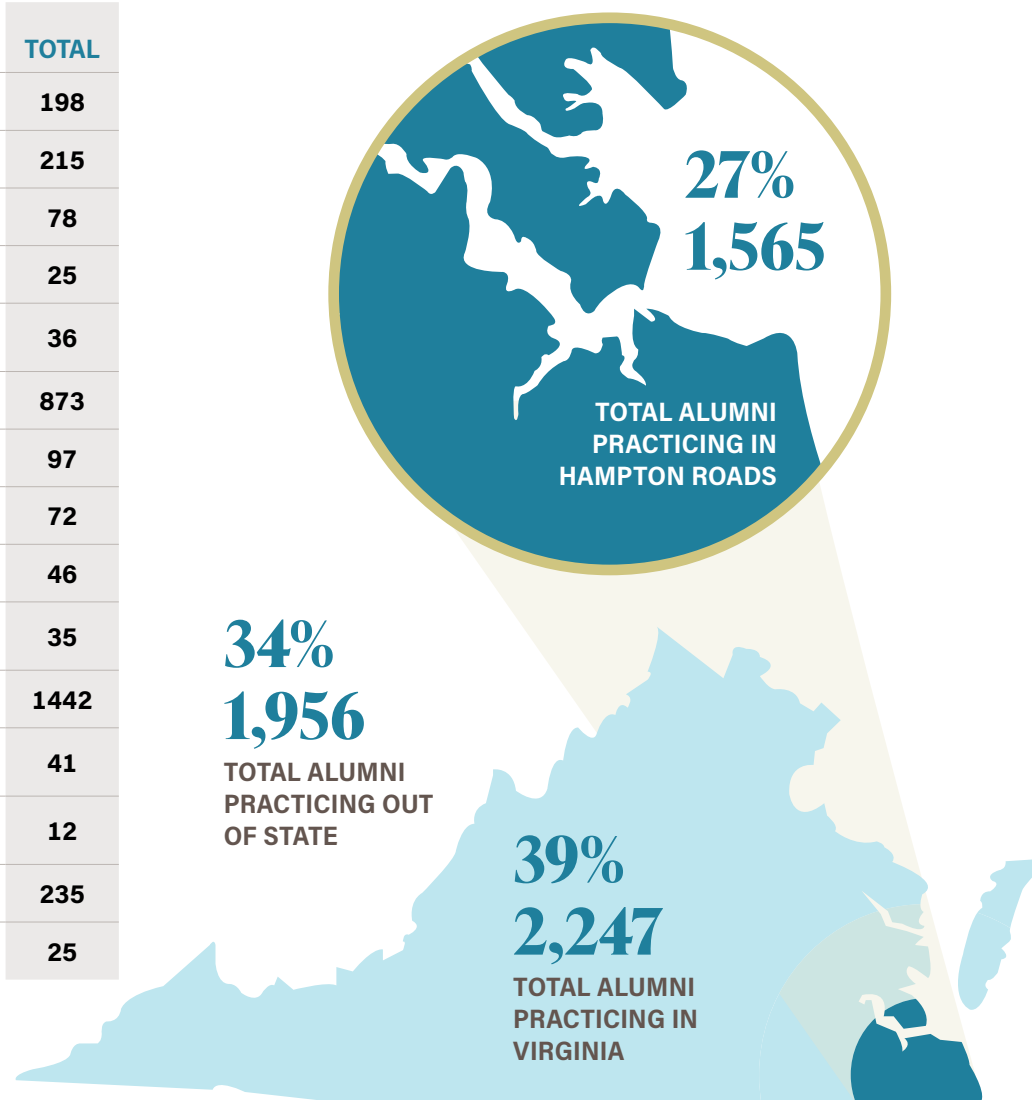
