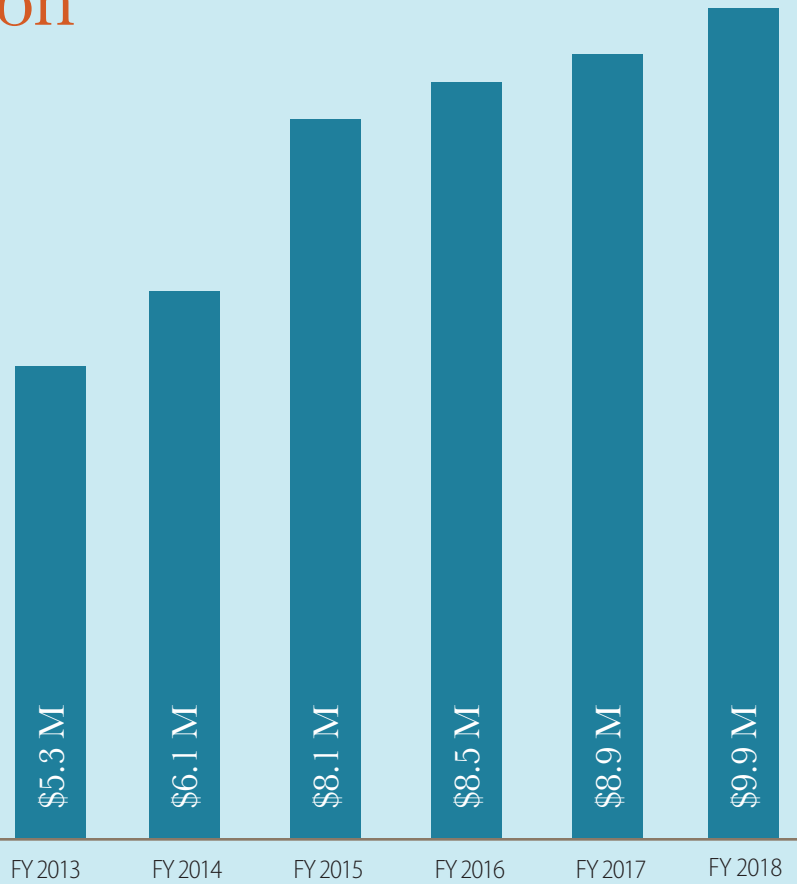

# Financial Information

In addition to strengthening the EVMS educational mission by managing more than 20 educational programs and establishing new programs, the School of Health Professions (SHP) makes a significant contribution to the institutional core budget. As depicted in the bar chart, the SHP net excess increased substantially between FY2013 and FY2018 from approximately \$5.3 million to \$9.9 million.
