
About the Program

The Master of Healthcare Delivery Science is designed to prepare the students to enter the healthcare workforce with skills and knowledge that will enable them to develop and promote better healthcare delivery and practice.

The program is committed to the core values of healthcare delivery, to better serve the population in terms of health care quality, accessibility, financing and information technology. The program will be taught by experienced faculty and health care leaders in the region who will share practical knowledge and perspectives in healthcare delivery innovation. The curriculum incorporates an array of topics in health analytics, leadership, strategy, finance, operations and effective information technology. Eastern Virginia Medical School plans to enroll the first cohort of students in this program in August 2017.

Curriculum and Course Delivery

This online program is designed to provide students with knowledge in health care delivery science and fundamental skills to contribute to the development of high-quality, patient-centered, safe and accessible healthcare. Students will be trained with the competencies required to participate in health care quality improvement and will be exposed to a variety of disciplines and tools, including health analytics, health disparities, health promotion, leadership skills, healthcare service and management.



Admission Requirements

- ❑ A Baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university with a competitive GPA (minimum 3.0 on a 4.0 scale).
- ❑ Three letters of reference.
- ❑ A personal statement outlining the applicant's academic and professional goals.

As part of a holistic review process, additional consideration will be given for appropriate work experience in a health-related field.

Application Procedure

All candidates must submit the following:

- ❑ Completed online application form
- ❑ Nonrefundable \$60 application fee
- ❑ Official transcripts of all coursework

- ❑ Resume or Curriculum Vitae with health related experience listed
- ❑ International students must submit TOEFL scores and have transcripts translated and evaluated by a third party (ECE or WES)
