

Tell us a little about yourself


I am a story-teller, co-creator, [and] innovator in medical education and clinical care, working to advance the way we meet the needs of those we serve. As a geriatrician and palliative medicine physician, I live and breathe this narrative. Collaborating with learners, patients and communities allows me to...contribute to important change that will advance care, and medical and health professions education.

You have a book chapter, "Acute Hospital Care" that has been accepted for publication. What was a challenge with this project?

The invitation to contribute to this chapter came in late 2019 and the bulk of writing...occurred during the early pandemic. .It was a long, but rewarding and collaborative team process that carried this to the finish line. One of the challenges with any book chapter is ensuring the most up-to-date evidence ...are included given the long time [between] publication and printing.

Do you have any advice for your colleagues about getting involved with research?

My best advice is. . . . jump in! Think about the work you are doing each day, the work you love. . . and pay attention to the questions you ask that are just craving answers! Get involved, try different experiences in research – find ways to explore the questions and curiosities that excite you. [R]egardless of the type of research you opt to pursue, [t]he process of discovery and co-creation of projects, developing collaborations, and sharing your findings...that's how research is best done.
