(2 full days protected time weekly to work with mentors at the Simulation & Immersive Learning Center)
- An enthusiastic group of PEM faculty (12) and fellows (6) many of whom have ongoing interests in Medical Simulation
- A mentored experience in simulation methodology in a brand new (opened 2012) and state of the art Center for Immersive Learning and Medical Simulation
